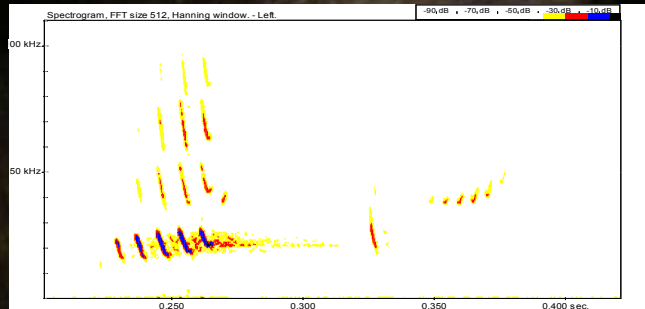


The Social Calls of Bats within The UK & Ireland
